

HOUSE WINE - FRANCE

- 1 Le Caprice Sauvignon Blanc 125ml £3.15 £13.95
Pays d'Oc, France
Bone dry, with a classic zesty gooseberry flavour typical of Sauvignon Blanc grown in the Charente region. (1)
- 2 Le Caprice Grenache Rosé 125ml £3.15 £13.95
Pays d'Oc, France
Delicately flavoured and dry from southern France, displaying hints of redcurrants and bramble fruits. (2)
- 3 Le Caprice Merlot 125ml £3.15 £13.95
Pays d'Oc, France
Fresh and juicy with notes of bramble fruit and plum backed by a soft long finish. (C)

- 4 House White 125ml £3.15 £12.95
Our good quality house white wine in dry finish.
- 5 House Red 125ml £3.15 £12.95
Our good quality red wine full fruity and velvet finish.
- 6 House Rosé 125ml £3.15 £12.95
Our good quality house rose delicious fruity flavour pink.

WHITE WINE

- 7 Cullinan View Pinotage, Western Cape, South Africa £16.95
Rich, full and spicy with good levels of fruit aromas and flavour, made with South Africa's own grape variety. (3)
- 8 The Gourmet Chardonnay South Australia £17.95
Fruit-driven Chardonnay, unoaked with zesty, citrusy fruit and a structure made for food. (2)
- 9 Monte Verde Sauvignon Blanc Central Valley, Chile £17.95
Classic gooseberry flavours enhanced by tropical fruit and zesty lemon. (2)
- 10 Parini Pinot Grigio delle Venezie, Italy £18.95
Distinctive nose of wild flowers, with touches of honey and banana; soft, fresh and lively with notes of ripe pear. (3)
- 11 Don Jacobo Rioja Blanco Bodegas Corral, Spain £18.95
Fresh, dry, crisp and modern, from this classic Spanish region using the local Viura grape. (2)
- 12 Vidal Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough New Zealand £19.95
Classically crisp and herbaceously intense with great complexity, a mingling of passion-fruit and melon flavours (1)
- 13 Chablis, Paul Deloux, France £25.95
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis. (1)
- 14 Sancerre, Les Collinettes Joseph Mellot, France £33.95
Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers. (1)

ROSÉ WINE

- 15 Whispering Hills White Zinfandel California, USA £18.95
Lots of fresh summer-fruit flavours and lively acidity. Medium-bodied to appeal to most palates, California's own Zinfandel. (5)

ROSÉ WINE

- 16 Parini Pinot Grigio Rosé delle Venezie, Italy £18.95
Soft, coppery-pink rosé; delicate and fruity bouquet; soft and fresh on the palate. (3)
- 17 Mateus Rosé, Sogrape Vinhos de Portugal £16.95
Soft, strawberry fruit on the nose and a gentle taste, with a slight sparkle. Easy to understand why this is so popular. (4)

RED WINE

- 18 The Gourmet Shiraz, South Australia £17.95
Restrained blackberry fruit backed by a crisp finish. (C)
- 19 Monte Verde Merlot, Central Valley, Chile £17.95
A supple and intensely juicy style with intense flavours of ripe red berries and plums. (C)
- 20 Cullinan View Pinotage, Western Cape South Africa £17.95
Rich, full and spicy with good levels of fruit aromas and flavour, made with South Africa's own grape variety. (B)
- 21 Celsus, Chianti, Italy £18.95
Grapes selected from the centre of Tuscany in between Florence and Siena are used to make this bright ruby red wine with its distinctive herbaceous and red fruit aromas. (B)
- 22 Marqués de Morano Rioja Crianza Tinto, Spain £19.95
Mazuelo adds a ripe cherry chunkiness to the smooth raspberries and cream style of Tempranillo. (C)
- 23 Vidal Pinot Noir, Hawke's Bay, New Zealand £20.95
Raspberry sweetness showing through a youthful character, yet more structure and complexity developing from barrique-ageing. (B)
- 24 Trivento Reserve Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina £23.95
Plum and raspberry dominate with notes of vanilla; the palate is velvety to the finish with a note of spice. (C)
- 25 Château Des Bardes, Saint-Emilion, France £23.95
Aged for over a year in Oak barrels giving a wine with sweet tannins, juicy backed by soft touches of vanilla toastiness. (B)
- 26 Fleurie Domaine de Poncereau, Louis Jadot, France £26.95
Elegant, silky; enveloping a plump, ripe berry, mouth-filling character and supple freshness. (B)
- 27 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Clos de L'Oratoire des Papes, Ogier, France £33.95
Surprising floral nose with notes of grass and acacia, evolving onto more classic notes of red berries; ample palate, with fine tannins and silky length. (D)

SPARKLING WINE

- 28 Sant' Orsola Prosecco Extra Dry, Italy £20.95
Light and lively, with ripe pears and lemons rounded off with a hint of sweetness. (2)
- 29 Pinot Cuvée Rosé Brut, Casa Sant' Orsola Italy £20.95
Fashionably pink this pear fizz is light, dry and refreshing. (2)
- 30 Louis Dornier et Fils Brut, Champagne £35.95
A light, fresh, vigorously youthful Champagne with a fine, elegant, slightly lemony nose, lively mousse and long, crisp palate. (1)
- 31 Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut, Champagne £80.95
The briefest liaison with grape skins tantalisingly leaves this delicate colour yet exudes a floral fragrance evolving soft red berry richness. (1)
- 32 Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial, Champagne £48.95
A well known blend of older reserves with young wines to ensure a consistency of this flowery aroma and warm biscuit hints. (1)
